Players of the Week

OFFENSE

Jordan Cannava, Fitchburg, Jr., QB, Woburn, Mass.

Cannava led Fitchburg State to a dramatic 37-34 double overtime victory over Coast Guard Academy, tossing for 307 yards and three touchdowns and 22-of-50 passing. Cannava led the game-tying and game-winning drives, tossing for two consecutive touchdowns. The junior QB also added a TD run on the ground, totaling four touchdowns on the day.

Jim Bower, Maine Maritime, Sr., RB, South Paris, Maine

252 yards on 28 carries with three TD's and a 9.0 yards/carry average.

John Creamer, Plymouth, Jr., WR, Abington, Mass.

Career-high nine receptions for 150 yards and two TD's (30, 32).

Justin Fuller, Bridgewater, Jr., RB, Berkley, Mass.

93 yards rushing, two TD's (9, 54), and threw a 20-yard halfback option pass for a score.

Eric Gerken, Coast Guard, Fr., WR, Tampa, Fla.

Two TD's among his six catches for 76 yards including a five-yard reception which forced a second overtime.

Luke Johnson, Westfield, So., RB, South Attleboro, Mass.

Rushed for 146 yards on 29 carries and scored the eventual game-winning touchdown.

Mike Lane, Endicott, So., RB, Medfield, Mass.

Averaged 8.5 yards/carry on 15 rushes for 127 yards and a touchdown.

Dave Leach, Framingham, Sr., RB, Chelmsford, Mass.

Rushed for 103 yards on 22 carries with two touchdowns.

Frank Scattaretico, WNEC, So., RB, Dobbs Ferry, NY

172 All-purpose yards with an 80-yard TD reception.

Sean Smith-Vaughan, Nichols, So., QB, Cumberland, Maine

Completed 21 of 33 passes (63.6%) for 213 yards, three TD's and a conversion including 82 yards passing on the game-winning drive.

23-of-37 passes for 232 yards and TD and rushed for 52 yards and two scores.
