### Players of the Week

#### OFFENSE

**Jesse Karr, Coast Guard, Jr., QB, Milan, Mich.**

Karr completed 10 of 24 passes for 168 yards with a career-high tying three touchdowns and no interceptions while also rushing for 53 yards on eight carries. He led the Bears on a game-winning fourth quarter drive for the second straight week as Coast Guard defeated Mass Maritime 29-22.

**Jim Bower, Maine Maritime, Sr., Fb, South Paris, Maine**

129 yards on 25 carries (5.0 yds./carry) and a touchdown.

**J.J. Brooks, Plymouth, Jr., QB, Seabrook, N.H.**

Completed 9-of-13 passes for 145 yards and three TD's and rushed for 77 yards on 20 carries (4.8 avg.) and a fourth score.

**DeRon Brown, MIT, Sr., RB, Galax, Va.**

Rushed for 267 yards on 31 carries (8.6 per) with TD's of 21, 66, and 76.

**Steve Clark, Bridgewater, Sr., QB, East Falmouth, Mass.**

158 rushing yards on 18 carries with a 69-yard TD, and 5-9 passing with a 30-yard score.

**Carlos De La Rosa, Fitchburg State, Jr., WR, Holyoke, Mass.**

136 yards on seven receptions with two TD's, including the game-winner with 0:58 remaining.

**Jonathan Emond, Mass. Maritime, Fr., WR, Green Harbor, Mass.**

Nine receptions for 152 yards and first collegiate touchdowns (58 and 19).

**JJ Jachym, Western New England, So., RB, Milford, Conn.**

A rushing and a receiving TD and a 5.5 yard average/carry.

**Luke Johnson, Westfield, So., RB, South Attleboro, Mass.**

Rushed for 127 yards on 30 carries, with a 1-yard TD run.

**Mike Lane, Endicott, So., RB, Medfield, Mass.**

Carried the ball 19 times for 133 yards (7.0/carry) and three scores.

**Dave Leach, Framingham, Sr., RB, Chelmsford, Mass.**

Leach rushed for 159 yards on 33 carries with a touchdown.

**Jamaal Woods, Curry, Sr., RB, Malden, Mass.**

Rushed for a game-high 130 yards on 18 carries.

#### DEFENSE

**Mike Riley, Maine Maritime, Sr., CB, Milton, Vt.**

Riley collected seven tackles and two interceptions as Maine Maritime held off Westfield 21-13. The senior also had three pass break-ups with two coming in the last few seconds of the game near the end zone. Both of Riley's interceptions came inside the 1-yard line. His first ended a Westfield drive for a touchback and his second ended a Westfield drive at the Maine Maritime 1-yard line.

Led the Bears with 12 tackles and recovered a fumble.

**Mike Bruning, Plymouth, Jr., LB, Abington, Mass.**

Forced a fumble, picked it up and ran 21 yards and made six tackles (two solo), including a half sack.

**Kyle Capsalis, Endicott, Jr., DB, Townsend, Mass.**

Returned an interception 26 yards for a TD and had three tackles and pass break up.

**Scott Driscoll, Curry, Sr., LB, North Andover, Mass.**

Made three 4th-quarter interceptions the last of which he returned for a 10-yard TD, three solo tackles and a pass break-up.

**Jim Erlwein, Mass. Maritime, Sr., DL, Livingston Manor, N.Y.**

Recorded 11 total tackles, including seven solo stops and 2.5 for losses.

**Will Glbson, MIT, Sr., LB, Natick, Mass.**

10 tackles (three solo), including one for a loss, and recovered a fumble that later resulted in a touchdown.

**Chris James, Westfield, Sr., LB, Athol, Mass.**

Game-high 13 tackles (8 solos) with a fumble recovery and a forced fumble

**Brent Loveless, Framingham State, Jr., DB, Billerica, Mass.**

Led the Rams with seven tackles including six solo stops and four pass break ups.

**Shawn Manning, UMass Dartmouth, So., S, Mansfield, Mass.**

Led Corsairs with 14 tackles, including eight solo stops and a 9-yard sack.

**Nolan McGarrity, Salve Regina, Sr., LB, Verona, N.J.**

Game-high 16 tackles (12 solo).

**Sean McGinn, Fitchburg State, Jr., DL, Walpole, Mass.**

Game-high 12 tackles (8 solo, 4 assists), added 0.5 sacks and 1.5 TFL.

**Alex Miller, Western New England, Fr., DB, Seekonk, Mass.**

Special teams player recovered two fumbles on punts which led to scores.

**Andrew Tokarz, Worcester, Jr., DB, Holden, Mass.**

Two interceptions, broke up two passes and finished with four tackles.
