Players of the Week

CO-OFFENSE

Nick Bourassa, Maine Maritime, So., RB, Jay, Maine

As the Mariners rushed for a DII/DIII record 730 yards on the day in a 76-49 victory over Coast Guard, Bourassa had 217 yards on only nine carries for an average of 24.1 yards per carry. Bourassa also scored four touchdowns. Bourassa had touchdown runs of 80, 9, 0, and 17-yards.

Jon Resch, Coast Guard, Fr., QB, Lititz, Pa.

Resch came off the bench late in the first quarter for the injured Jesse Karr and proceeded to set school records with 469 passing yards and six touchdowns while tying a school-record with 34 completions in the 76-49 loss. He was 34 for 46 with one interception. The old school records were 412 yards and four touchdowns.

David Benoit, Westfield, Sr., WR, Ludlow, Mass.

Four catches for 75 yards, including TD catches of 42 and 25 yards.

DeRon Brown, MIT, Sr., RB, Galax, Va.

Totaled 103 yards on 32 rushes.

Michael Dargan, Salve Regina, WR, So, Meriden, Conn.

Caught 10 passes for 153 yards, including a 91-yard touchdown.

Justin Fuller, Bridgewater, Jr., RB, Berkley, Mass.

Rushed for 102 yards and three touchdowns on 19 carries.

Mike Graham, WNEC, Fr., RB, Norwalk, Conn.

12.5 avg. on six carries with a pair of TD's (30, 4) and the game winner.

Jeremy Kimber, Fitchburg, So., WR, Fitchburg, Mass.

Two TDs, 79 yards receiving, 38 yards rushing, and 58 yards passing.

Dave Leach, Framingham, Jr., RB, Chelmsford, Mass.

Became the Framingham carer rushing leader as he gained 171 yards and a score on 32 carries (5.3 yds/carry).

Ty Long, Plymouth, Fr., RB, Dover, N.H.

Rushed for 127 yards on 17 carries (7.5 avg.) and a 51-yard touchdown.

Victor Martinez, Curry, Fr., WR, Southbridge, Mass.

Team-high eight receptions and game-high 129 receiving yards.

Anthony Pillari, Nichols Sr., WR, Lumberton, N.J.

Broke the Nichols single season (51) and career (131) receptions record with eight catches for 67 yards, flicked a 2-yard TD pass, had 49 kick return yards, and averaged 37.5 yards on six punts.

CO-DEFENSE

Wade Mondoux, Maine Maritime, Jr., LB, Berwick, Maine

Mondoux had a career day in MMA's historic 76-49 win over Coast Guard. Mondoux collected 14 tackles including 12 solo and had 4.5 tackles for loss. He also had a sack and an interception in which he returned 28 yards to set up a score.

Chris Stengel, Westfield, Jr., P, Forest Hill, Md.

Stengel had a sensational day, punting 10 times for a 45.5 yard average. Six of his punts were inside the 20, four traveled 50 or more yards, with a long of 61 yards; 1 was a touchback, and two were fair catches. In addition, Stengel kicked off five times, averaging 56.8 yards, with two of his kickoffs (72 and 73 yards in the air) going into the end zone. Additionally, he made three PATs and a field goal in the Owls 32-16 win over Fitchburg.
