Rushed for 110 yards on 15 carries and two TDs (7.3 yards per rush).

Evan Berneche, Westfield, Jr., WR, Chicopee, Mass.

Five catches for 84 yards and two touchdowns (10 and 44 yards).

J.J. Brooks, Plymouth, Jr., QB, Seabrook, N.H.

Rushed for 108 yards on 16 carries (6.8 avg.) and three touchdowns.

Rushed for 119 yards on 31 carries in final collegiate appearance.

Led Fitchburg with five catches for 108 yards and one TD.

Rushed for 133 yards, with a long of 17.

Led the Rams with eight catches for 131 yards and a touchdown.

Costello intercepted three passes one in each in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarters. His final one came with 2:33 left in the game at the Coast Guard 30-yard line. Costello also had another pass break-up and three tackles.

O'Connell accounted for three turnovers with two interceptions (22 return yards), and a fumble recovery. O'Connell also forced a fumble recovery, and made eight tackles including six solo stops.
