

# New England Football Conference Players of the Week and Honor Roll

## Week of September 12, 2009

### Players of the Week

#### OFFENSE

**Nathan Sherr, So., RB, Lynnfield, Mass.**

Rushed for school-record 325 yards on 26 carries and scored three as a starting quarterback. Completed 12 of 25 passes for 190 yards (60, touchdowns on runs of 1, 3, and 95 yards to lift Buccaneers to 49-27 victory over MIT and snap a 12 game losing streak. Sherr was named the New England Football Writers Gold Helmet award winner for the week.

**Steve Austin, Fitchburg, Sr., RB, Jupiter, Fla.**

168 rushing yards on 28 carries (6.0 yds/c) and three touchdowns with 48 yards receiving to total 216 all purpose yards.

**Nick Bourassa, Maine Maritime, So., RB, Jay, Maine**

Seven rushes times for 180 yards (25.3/carry) and an 82 yard touchdown. Also had one kick return for 22 yards.

**J.J. Brooks, Plymouth, Jr., QB, Seabrook, N.H.**

Completed 8-of-9 passes for 154 yards and one touchdown, and he rushed for two touchdowns (5 & 3 yards).

**Justin Fuller, Bridgewater, Jr., RB, Berkley, Mass.**

Rushed for 186 yards and a 53-yard touchdown on just 14 carries, for an average of 13.1 yards per carry.

**Luke Johnson, Westfield, So., RB, South Attleboro, Mass.**

Rushed 28 times for 155 yards and a touchdown (5). Also caught a pass for six yards.

**Jesse Karr, Coast Guard, Jr, QB, Milan, Mich.**

29 of 52 passing attempts for 338 yards and three touchdowns with no interceptions.

**Anthony Kewley, Framingham, Sr., WR, Rutland, Mass.**

240 all-purpose yards including 87 receiving yards, 37 kick return yards and 116 punt return yards including an 80 yard touchdown.

#### DEFENSE

**John Ferbert, Bridgewater, Sr., LB, East Bridgewater, MA**

Ferbert paced the BSC defense as he recorded 11 tackles to go along with a forced fumble, two fumble recoveries and an interception. His second forced fumble was scooped up by teammate Steve Tripp who rambled 45 yards for a touchdown.

#### Honor Roll

**Bryan Anderson, Westfield, Jr., LB, Stoneham, Mass.**

Eight tackles (seven solos including two sacks), a fumble recovery, and a tipped pass on an interception that set up Westfield's second TD.

**Scott Driscoll, Curry, Sr., LB, North Andover, Mass.**

Driscoll had a team-high six tackles (all solo) and ran back a first-quarter interception 55 yards for a touchdown.

**Christian Guzman, Fitchburg, Fr., LB, Lawrence, Mass.**

Game-high nine tackles (5 solo, 4 assists), including one stop for a two-yard loss.

**Ryan Howley, Mass Maritime, Sr., LB, New Fairfield, Conn.**

Amassed 11 total tackles (eight solo) and two tackles for losses of seven yards.

**Nolan McGarrity, Salve Regina University, Sr., LB, Verona, N.J.**

11 tackles (five solo) and intercepted two passes. He recorded 1.5 tackles for loss.

**Wade Mondoux, Maine Maritime, Jr., LB, North Berwick, Maine**

Seven solo tackles a sack for a 4-yard loss and two tackles for losses that totaled 10 yards.

**Anthony Pappagallo, Framingham, Jr., S, Malden, Mass.**

Eight tackles, three pass break ups and an interception that he returned 41 yards to set up a touchdown.

**Tyler Russell, Worcester, Jr., LB, Princeton, Mass.**

Russell tallied seven solo tackles with a tackle for a loss.
