### Players of the Week

#### OFFENSE

**J.J. Brooks, Plymouth, Jr., QB, Seabrook, N.H.**

Accounted for all four Panther touchdowns, including two in the fourth quarter as Plymouth State pulled out a 28-17 victory over Coast Guard. Brooks rushed for 81 yards and two touchdowns while completing 5-of-10 passes for 77 yards and two scores. He led PSU to a come-from-behind victory with a nine-yard TD pass with 8:49 left in the fourth quarter and added an insurance score with a three-yard TD plunge with 4:33 remaining.

**Kyle Anderson, Westfield, So., QB, Westminster, Mass.**

Completed 15 of 38 passes for 168 yards, and rushed for 54 net yards on 14 carries.

**Jim Bower, Maine Maritime, Sr., RB, South Paris, Maine**

Averaged 5.5 yards per rush on 165 yards rushing on 30 carries with two touchdowns.

**Jordan Cannava, Fitchburg, Jr., QB, Woburn, Mass.**

185 yards passing on 16-of-26 attempts with one touchdown through the air, and 40 rushing yards with a touchdown.

**Justin Fuller, Bridgewater, Jr., RB, Berkley, Mass.**

Rushed for 127 yards on 27 carries and scored on runs of 2 and 1 yard.

**Phil Konopka, Endicott, So., QB, Shelton, Conn.**

16-of-24 passing for 233 yards with three TD's (24, 32 and 34 yards)

**James McCarthy, Framingham, So., WR, Newton, Mass.**

16 catches for 157 yards including a 16-yard reception in the final minute that set up the game winning touchdown.

**Robert Morris, Nichols, Sr., RB, Melbourne, Fla.**

126 rushing yards on 31 carries with two TD's and 145 all-purpose yards.

**Jeff St. Onge, Salve Regina, Sr., QB, Kingston, N.H.**

Completed 24-of-37 passes for 275 yards and three touchdowns (52, 65 and 8 yards). His third with 3:57 remaining in the game broke a 20-20 tie.

**Matthew Spinazzola, Mass. Maritime, Fr, QB, Melbourne, Fla.**

12-of-22 passes for 125 yards and a pair of touchdowns of 25 and 4 yards.

**Tony Tokarz, Worcester, So, QB, Holden, Mass.**

282 yards of total offense for WSC (201 passing-80 rushing) as he tossed a pair of touchdowns and ran for a score.

#### DEFENSE

**Kevin Eagan, Endicott, So., LB, West Hartford, Conn.**

Eagan had a game-high 14 tackles, three of which resulted in a loss of three yards, and a forced fumble in Endicott's 34-23 win over Mass. Maritime. Eagan had seven solo and seven assisted tackles in the victory.
